Our Early Years

In 2020 and 2021, despite having zero experience in running an NGO, I started planting trees with the help of my family and friends. In 2022, we collaborated with Young Indians Dehradun team for a Miyawaki plantation drive in Jakhan, Dehradun. We planted around 120 saplings, and their team took excellent care of them. Today, that barren land has transformed into a thriving mini-forest. This experience taught me the importance of proper care and maintenance for saplings.



Challenges and Realizations

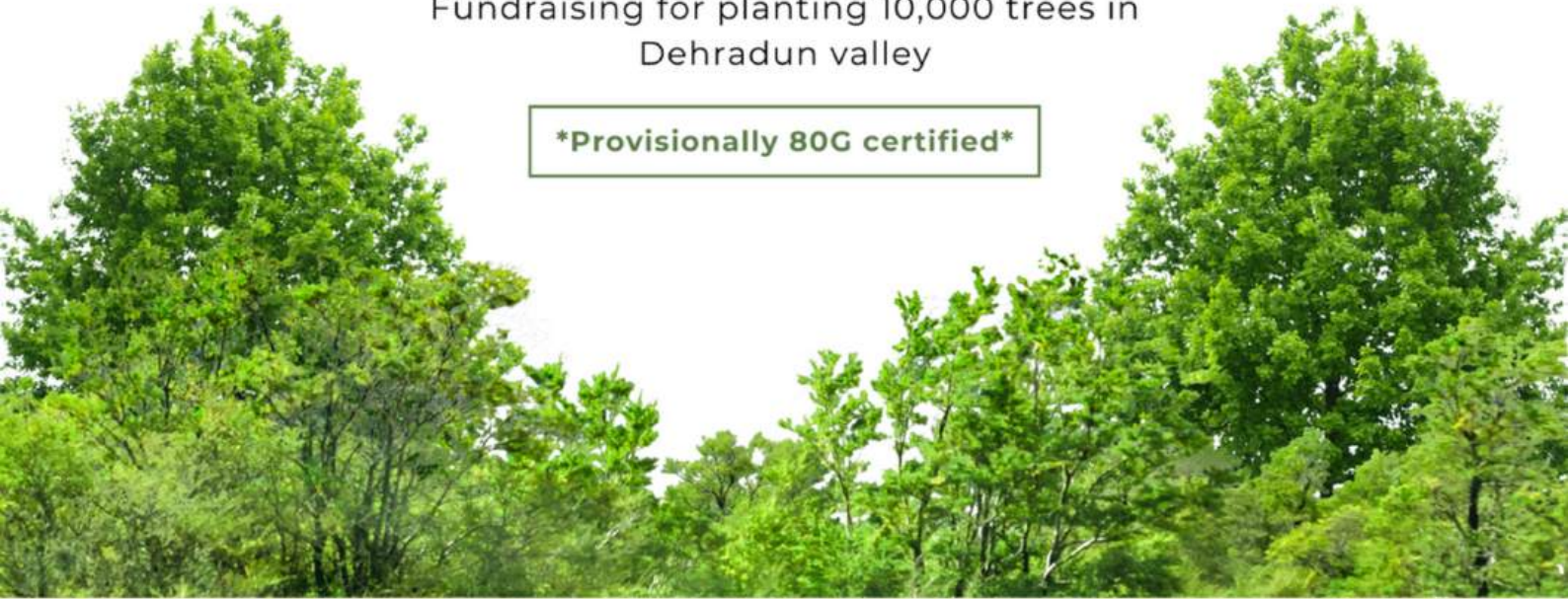

A New Approach

So, in 2025, I decided that we wouldn't conduct any plantation drives without sufficient funds. That's why we're raising funds for our "Reviving Doon Valley" project, aiming to plant 10,000 saplings in and around Dehradun. We require approximately ₹25 lakhs for execution and maintenance over the next few years.

Planting trees involves extensive planning, logistics, paperwork, and fundraising. It's a challenging journey, but I'm committed to making it happen. I've faced numerous rejections, doubtful gestures, and mental tolls, but I'm determined to succeed.

Transparency and Accountability

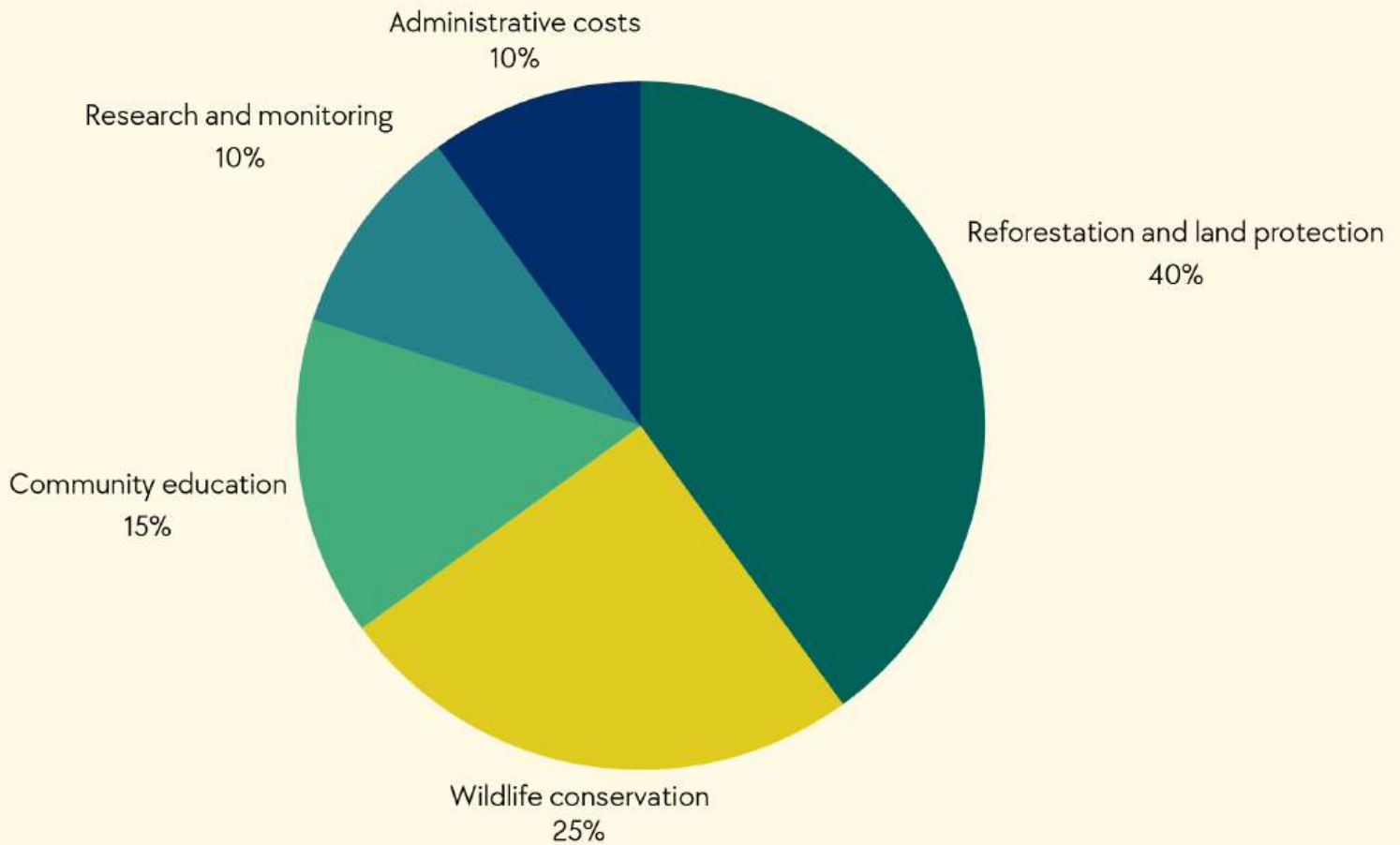
